

MEET OLIVER LARKIN



Oliver Larkin is a digital marketer, campaign advisor, and union organizer from Fort Lauderdale. Born on the 4th of July in an Army family, Oliver learned about the value of public service and the importance of education from his parents.

Oliver graduated from Phillips Exeter Academy in 2011 and from Sewanee: The University of the South in 2015, where he studied English, history, creative writing, and played four years on the football team. After graduation, he left his job as a line cook to volunteer for Bernie Sanders' campaign, working as an organizer and regional field director across the country from July 2015 to April 2016.

Oliver worked with the Sanders-inspired organization Our Revolution and their president Nina Turner to lobby Congress and elect progressives, while making national headlines helping unionize his workplace with the NewsGuild-CWA.

To maximize his impact for the progressive movement, Oliver became a marketing director raising millions for Democratic leaders in the House and Senate. Seeing the need in his hometown of Florida's 23rd district greater than ever, he is ready to represent his community with the servant leadership that has defined his work for the past decade.

ABOUT FL-23


Florida's 23rd is an urban, diverse South Florida district with a median age of 45. Nearly 30% are immigrants, 45% are people of color, and 32% report speaking a non-English language at home. More than 75,000 lack health insurance.

The wealthiest district in Florida, FL-23 is at the heart of the affordability crisis, with a rising poverty rate in a state where **half of residents are considering leaving due to the skyrocketing cost of living.**

FL-23 is a D+2 district with a 5% congressional margin of victory in 2024. With Democratic margins improving through 2025, it is well-suited for a more progressive representative.

THE INCUMBENT CONGRESSMAN JARED MOSKOWITZ

Congressman Jared Moskowitz has voted with Republicans to censure Democrats, empower ICE, and support Trump's militarism after Florida Governor Ron DeSantis granted him multiple political appointments.

According to the Center for Effective Lawmaking, **Moskowitz is Florida's least effective Democrat in Congress**. He misses votes, dodges town halls, and was the only Florida Democrat to back Trump's racist immigration law and the first in the nation to join the GOP's DOGE Caucus.

Moskowitz has accepted **\$646,929** from pro-Israel groups, traded nearly **\$4 million** in stock while in office—joining Marjorie Taylor Greene to buy the dip in Trump's trade war—and continues to take corporate PAC money from Big Sugar, Big Pharma, fossil fuels, and banks.

While Moskowitz makes local headlines for his stock trades and avoiding town halls, FL-23 is missing the Democratic leadership in Washington we voted for.

South Florida families need a representative who shows up for us in South Florida and Washington and stands up to extremism in the Republican Party. **Oliver Larkin is running a serious, viable campaign to bring progressive leadership rooted in community, accountability, and a commitment to the people of FL-23 to Congress.**

PATHWAY TO VICTORY

As the number of registered Democratic voters in the district has declined, election turnout in the Trump-era 2018 and 2022 midterms has remained steady above 30%. 63,524 voters participated in Florida's August 2022 23rd district Democratic primary. 38,822 — 61.1% of voters — cast a ballot for Jared Moskowitz, with nearly 40% voting against him, comprising 24,702 voters.

Despite weak primary opposition and more than 60 endorsements from federal, state, and local officials, Moskowitz drew below 50% of the vote in one-quarter of Broward County precincts, with notably poor performance in Black, Hispanic, immigrant, and low-income parts of the 23rd district. More than 25,000 Democratic voters have become inactive or been removed from the voter rolls since 2022.


With a projected 2026 midterm turnout of 31%, out of 186,536 active Democratic voters we expect 58,000 primary voters. Our win number of 29,001, with a safe win number of 31,901, is well within reach.
