

MEET OLIVER LARKIN



Oliver Larkin is a union organizer from Fort Lauderdale. Born on the 4th of July in an Army family, he graduated from Phillips Exeter Academy in 2011 and Sewanee: The University of the South in 2015, where he played on the football team.

Oliver was a regional field director on Sen. Bernie Sanders' 2016 presidential campaign and organized a union with the NewsGuild-Communication Workers of America. After working as a marketing director for Democratic campaigns, Oliver is primarying incumbent U.S. Rep. Jared Moskowitz (FL-23).

ABOUT FL-23


FL-23 is a diverse urban district with a median age of 45 in Broward and Palm Beach County. Nearly 30% are immigrants, 45% are people of color, and 32% speak a non-English language. Over 75,000 lack health insurance.

FL-23's Fort Lauderdale and Wilton Manors had the highest proportions of LGBTQ+ households among medium and small-sized cities in the 2020 census.

FL-23 is a D+2 seat with a 5% House 2024 margin of victory that is shifting left with the state. In March 2026, FL-23's Boca Raton elected its first Democratic mayor in 31 years. In Palm Beach County, Democrat Emily Gregory flipped an R+9 state house district covering Mar-a-Lago, and Mayor Eileen Higgins flipped Miami blue in December 2025 for the first time in 25 years.

Jared Moskowitz has voted with Republicans to censure Democrats, empower ICE, and enable Trump's war with Iran.

The University of Virginia and Vanderbilt University's Center for Effective Lawmaking rated Moskowitz as **Florida's least effective Democrat in Congress.**

While AIPAC-backed Jared Moskowitz makes local headlines for his stock trades and no public town halls, FL-23 is missing the Democratic leadership in Washington we voted for.

INFORMED VOTERS CHOOSE OLIVER LARKIN

Initial head-to-head polling puts Moskowitz ahead of Larkin, 45%-11%, with 44% undecided. An informed ballot of positive biographies lead to a surge in Larkin's support, taking a 49%-36% lead. After negative biographies are included, Larkin's lead increases further to 51%-32%.

By a 2-to-1 margin, FL-23 likely Democratic voters support conditioning, reducing, or eliminating military aid to Israel.

With the resources to increase Larkin's name recognition, polling shows a clear pathway to victory.

PATHWAY TO VICTORY

Larkin's campaign has raised over \$325,000 for the 2026 election cycle, with half of that cash on hand, and a goal of spending \$2.5 million on paid media between the campaign and independent expenditures.

As registered Democrats in the district have declined, turnout in 2018 and 2022 has remained above 30%. 63,524 voters participated in Florida's August 2022 FL-23 primary. 38,822—61.1% of voters—cast a ballot for Jared Moskowitz, with nearly 40%—24,702 voters—voting against him.

Moskowitz was below 50% in one-quarter of Broward County precincts in 2022, with notably poor performance in Black, Hispanic, immigrant, and low-income parts of the 23rd district. More than 25,000 Democratic voters have become inactive or been removed from the voter rolls since 2022.


With a projected 2026 midterm turnout of 33.4%, out of 186,536 active Democratic voters we expect 62,203 primary voters. Our win number of 31,152 is well within reach.

Oliver Larkin's campaign in FL-23 is one of the most competitive and winnable Democratic primaries in the nation in 2026.
