

MEET OLIVER LARKIN

Oliver is a Fort Lauderdale native and a decade-long progressive organizer, fighting for Medicare for All, a \$25 minimum wage, the Green New Deal, universal childcare, free public college, paid family and medical leave, abolishing ICE, and an end to the US-funded genocide in Gaza. He rejects all corporate PAC money.

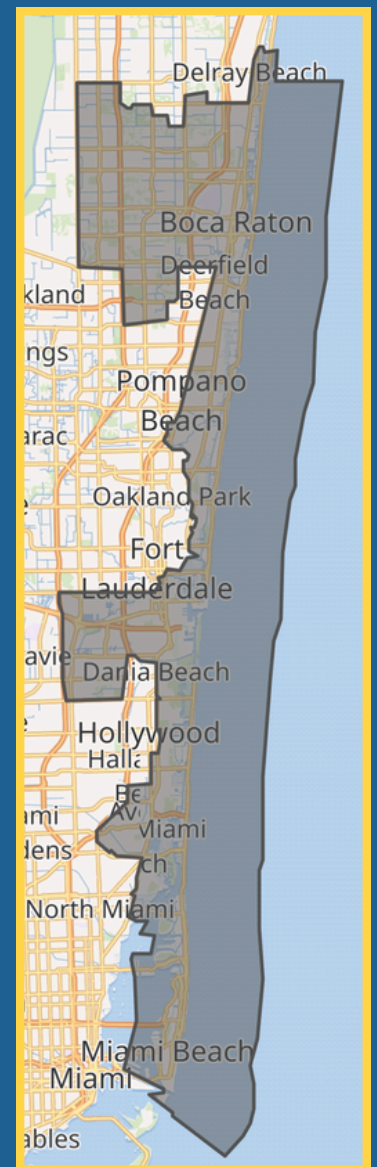
From leading a Bernie Sanders field office in 2016 to unionizing his workplace with the NewsGuild-CWA, Oliver took what he learned and put it to work in South Florida, organizing against luxury developers, fighting toxic landfill expansion, standing with LGBTQIA+ communities, and confronting groups like Moms for Liberty and the Proud Boys alongside families, educators, and students as an active member of Broward DSA.

ABOUT FL-25

FL-25 is moving left. Democrats carried the area of this new district the last time Trump was in the White House, and the ground is shifting away from Republicans. In March 2026, Boca Raton elected its first Democratic mayor in 31 years. In December 2025, Miami flipped blue for the first time in a quarter century. An R+9 state house district in Palm Beach County covering Mar-a-Lago went Democratic. Even so, Moskowitz has voted with Republicans on ICE, Iran, and the DOGE Caucus — moving right while his district moves left.

FL-25 sits on South Florida's Atlantic coast, spanning Miami-Dade, Broward and Palm Beach counties. 40% of residents are people of color, with strong immigrant and LGBTQ+ populations, including Miami Beach and Fort Lauderdale, the highest-proportion LGBTQ+ mid-sized city in America.

THE INCUMBENT: CONGRESSMAN JARED MOSKOWITZ

Jared Moskowitz has voted with Republicans to censure Democrats, empower ICE, and enable Trump's war with Iran. He was the first House Democrat to join Elon Musk's DOGE Caucus and the only Florida Democrat to vote for the Laken Riley Act. He personally recommended a GEO Group executive to lead Florida Atlantic University, which became one of the first universities in the country to sign a 287(g) agreement with ICE. His biggest domestic donors are Big Pharma, fossil fuel companies, banks, insurance, and real estate: the industries making his constituents' lives worse.

He doesn't hold public town halls. A large share of local headlines covering him are about his stock trades.

Funded by AIPAC, Enabling the Genocide in Gaza

AIPAC is Moskowitz's single largest donor, and he delivers. He has voted for every military aid package to Israel, led on eight AIPAC-supported bills, and publicly refuses to condition U.S. weapons even while acknowledging Israel has violated international law. He called the Iran War Powers Resolution the "Ayatollah Protection Act," aligning himself with Republicans Marco Rubio, Tom Cotton, and Lindsey Graham.

Tens of thousands of Palestinians have been killed in the genocide, the majority of them women and children. Neighborhoods have been flattened, including by the Caterpillar D9 bulldozers Moskowitz owns stock in. 86% of primary voters and 68% of general voters favor conditioning or stopping aid to Israel all together. Moskowitz represents the AIPAC position, not his voters'.

He Uses His Congressional Seat to Enrich Himself

Moskowitz has built a \$4 million stock portfolio from his seat on the House Foreign Affairs Committee, trading in the defense contractors, fossil fuel companies, and banks he votes on. He sold Florida bank stock the day Silicon Valley Bank collapsed, two days before a private congressional briefing on the banking crisis. He bought twenty stocks at multi-month lows on April 7, 2025, forty-eight hours before Trump reversed the tariffs that caused the crash. One of those buys was Caterpillar, whose armored D9 bulldozers are a primary tool in the genocide, used to demolish Palestinian homes, raze refugee camps, and tear out olive groves. He bought at roughly \$267 per share. It trades above \$800 today. He has bought Lockheed Martin stock four times, filing one purchase 190 days late in violation of the STOCK Act.

On Wall Street, these trades would trigger SEC investigations and end careers. 86% of Americans want to ban congressional stock trading. Moskowitz keeps trading.



A DIFFERENT KIND OF CONGRESSMEMBER

Oliver will take no corporate PAC, AIPAC, or defense contractor money. He will hold regular public town halls in every corner of the district. He will be accountable to the voters who elect him, not to the industries he'll vote on.

He will vote no on blank-check war authorizations and weapons packages that flow without conditions. He will caucus with the progressives fighting for Medicare for All, a \$25 minimum wage, abolishing ICE, and a ceasefire in Gaza.

Oliver will organize Congress the way he has organized his workplace: building coalitions, applying pressure, and refusing to accept that a Democratic Party captured by corporate money is the only one possible.

THE MORE VOTERS LEARN, THE MORE THEY CHOOSE OLIVER LARKIN

Initial head-to-head polling puts Moskowitz ahead 45%-11%, with 44% undecided. Once voters hear positive biographies of both candidates, Larkin takes a 49%-36% lead. Once they also hear criticism of both, his lead grows to 51%-32%.

With the resources to increase Larkin's name recognition, polling shows a clear pathway to victory.

PATHWAY TO VICTORY

Larkin's campaign has raised nearly \$400k, with half of that cash on hand, and a fundraising target of \$2.5 million for the August primary that he's well on the way to hit.

Moskowitz is weaker now than he has ever been. In the 2022 open-seat primary, he walked in with every advantage: \$1.1 million in the bank, an endorsement from Hillary Clinton, the backing of the House Democratic leadership, and a fractured field of underfunded first-time candidates with little name recognition. He still only took 61% of the primary vote. Nearly 40% of Democratic primary voters chose somebody else.

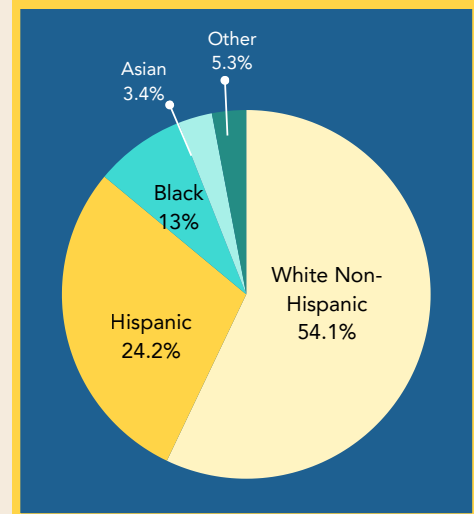
That was before he joined DOGE. Before he backed Trump's war with Iran. Before he became one of Congress's most visible stock traders. Before he bought Caterpillar stock at the bottom of the market while the company's bulldozers tore down Palestinian neighborhoods in Gaza. Even without any of that, FL-23 was the closest U.S. House race in Florida in 2024. Moskowitz won his general election with just 53%.

That 40% anti-Moskowitz vote is Oliver's floor. The campaign needs to grow it by ten points to clear 50%. The CSP poll demonstrates that's achievable: once voters hear both candidates' records, Oliver moves from 11% to 51%.

Oliver Larkin's campaign in FL-25 is one of the most competitive and winnable Democratic primaries in the nation in 2026.
